



5th Annual Bulldog Invitational

Where: University High School - 6525 W. 18th Street Greeley, CO

When: **IMPORTANT – THE TRACK MEET WILL BE HELD EITHER FRIDAY 4/30, SATURDAY 5/1, OR MONDAY 5/3 DEPENDING ON WEATHER. WE WILL DECIDE ON WEDNESDAY 4/28 AND CONTACT ALL SCHOOLS INVOLVED. THE START TIME IS 10:00 ON SATURDAY. IF WE MOVE TO FRIDAY OR MONDAY THE START TIME WILL BE 12:00 AND WE WILL HAVE NO POLE VAULT. If the meet is held on Saturday May 1st we will hold the pole vault at Eaton High School at 4:00 on Friday April 30th.**

General Information

- State Qualifying:** The Bulldog Invitational is a state pre-qualifying event. This meet is sanctioned by CHSAA.
- Facilities:** The track consists of 8 lanes and is made of black latex rubber. The long/triple/pole vault runways as well as the high jump pad are also made of latex. All competitors' shoes must use spikes of 1/8" or less. We will check spike lengths and athletes may be disqualified for violations. The shot put and discus pads are made from cement. **The shotput and discus will be thrown on a 34.92 degree sector.** Starting blocks will be provided. All other equipment will need to be supplied by the competing schools. **NO** locker rooms available for changing.
- Pole Vault:** Pole vault will be contested Friday, April 30th at Eaton High School in Eaton, CO at 4:00. See above.
- Parking:** Bus parking will be located along the 18th street. University's parking lot will be reserved for spectators.
- Camps/Warm-up:** Team camps will be allowed on the grassy area on the East side of the track. **No footballs, Frisbees, stereos, etc. will be allowed in the team camp area.** The warm-up area for athletes will be on the North side of the football field. Athletes **WILL NOT** be allowed on the infield of the track and the warm-up area unless they have been called or are participating in their event. Athletes will be able to view races from the team camp area.
- Concessions:** A concession stand will be located on the South side of the Auditorium. A hospitality room will also be available to coaches and meet workers in the school.
- Schools:** The schools that are confirmed to the Bulldog Invitational are: Brush, Dayspring, Eaton, Estes Park, Fort Lupton, Highland, Holy Family, Mead, Middle Park, Platte Canyon, Platte Valley, Saint Mary's, University, Valley, Weld Central, and Wiggins.
- Scoring:** Eight places will be scored (10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1) in all track events, field events, and relays.
- Awards:** Plaques will be awarded to the 1st and 2nd place boys and the 1st and 2nd place girls teams. Medals will be awarded for first through third place in all events. Ribbons will be awarded for 4th-8th place in all events.
- Entries:** Each school will be limited to **three** entries in individual events and **one** entry in relay events. Athletes are limited to only **four** events, including relays. All running events will be contested as finals in heats against time. We will run two heats of the 800m if needed and the 1600m and 3200m runs will utilize a "super alley" start. There will be preliminaries and finals of the field events with the top **nine** athletes advancing to the finals.
- Coaches Meeting:** We will have a coaches meeting at 9:30 in the cafeteria of the school. We will have computers set up to do scratches and/or substitutions on Milesplit. The registration will close at 9:30am and no changes will be allowed after that time.
- Rules:** All National Federation and CHSAA rules will be enforced at this meet (including uniform rule).
- Entry Deadline:** We will be utilizing the Milesplit website this year to process rosters and entries. The entry deadline will be at 9:30 am on Saturday May 1st or 11:00 am on Friday (4/30) or Monday (5/3). The entries can be accessed through <http://co.milesplit.us>.
- Entry Fee:** Entry fee is \$175.00 for each school or \$10.00 per athlete if less than 17 athletes. Please pay ASAP.
